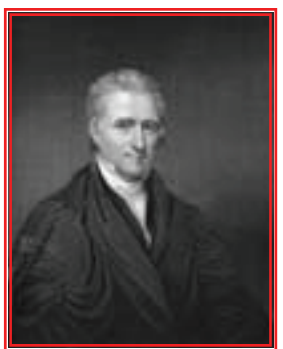
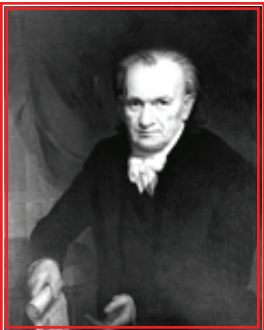
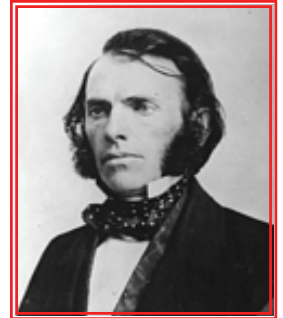
LUNCH WITH RENSSELAER'S LEADERS OF THE PAST
